ACHIEVEMENTS

BETTER BUSINESS ENVIRONMENT



€72 million

less burden on the economy due to the prevented mini-tax reform

€25.5 million

less burden on energy-intensive companies than forecasted in regard with environmental and energy-related fees

€15 million

savings for the steel industry and for waste collectors and treatment operators owing to more realistic requirements for the storage of waste



€13 million

savings to provide a public utility service to operate public bus services



€10 million

less burden on energy-intensive companies on account of the lower contribution for renewable energy sources and combined heat and power generation



€10 million

relief for bus companies on account of the extension of the tax relief for the purchase of ecological buses



savings for the wood processing industry, where residual wood can be used as fuel and is not required to be treated as waste

€2 million

savings for housing funds resulting from the amendments to the Rules on the methodology for the production and issuance of energy performance certificates for buildings



€2 million

savings on account of preventing an increase in water concession fees



Public procurement: prohibited use of prices as the only criterion for selection in certain industries, assessment of abnormally low bids, more proportionate distribution of contractors' and subcontractors' obligations and rights

RULE OF LAW



Act Amending the Companies Act (ZGD-11)

Stricter provisions relating to the prevention of the chaining of companies, reduction of excessively inflated fines for minor offences, etc.

€3 million

savings in telecommunication services, for the supply of power, gas, steam, water, sewage and waste management, as invoice issuance via fiscal cash registers is not required



Introduction of fiscal cash registers

As of 1 January 2016, including the action plan for the inspection and supervision of the performance of unregistered activities

DEVELOPMENTAL IMPETUS

€50 million

for the development of timber processing chains until 2020 and the establishment of a wood processing directorate



more investments in energy efficiency improvements to multi-apartment buildings



for the environmental infrastructure of the Brežice hydroelectric power station

within the budget for 2015

€6 million

approved funds for the technological modernisation of the timber-processing and furniture industry



Increased supply of loans

to SMEs from SID bank's loan fund (€88.2 million in 2014 and 2015)

Establishment of an independent Slovenian Tourist Board (STB)

The STB is crucial for more effective promotion of Slovenian tourism




